



Workshop and Tour

Where: Lake Forest Subdivision in Carmel (Located on the north side of 116th Street, just west of Hazel Dell Parkway)

Join the Hamilton County Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) and Lake Forest Subdivision for a morning of Backyard Conservation education.

- * Learn about pond edge enhancements and how they can benefit your neighborhood's pond or lake.
- * Tour a 5-acre arboretum and learn about the native trees, shrubs, and wildflowers growing there. If you're lucky, you may get to see the resident pileated woodpecker!
- * Discover tips for working on backyard projects in urban areas - including working around utilities, easements, and rights-of-way.
- * Learn how the Backyard Conservation Program can help you do this in *your* neighborhood.
